Bodega Parra Jimenez - DO La Mancha, Valencia, Spain

Verdejo 2015 (11.5% ABV)


Lemons, limes and white peaches on the palette with strong minerality. A crisp, dry wine that is perfect for an aperitif or goes wonderfully with fish and salads.

Bodega Enguera - Valencia, Spain

Finca Enguera Blanc 2014/15 (11.5% ABV)

A deliciously fresh everyday wine. Ripe lychees on the nose, it fills the mouth and ends with a smooth finish. Extremely good value for money.

Domaine Gustavshof - Gau-Heppenheim, Germany

Riesling Kalkstein 2014 (12.0 % ABV)

A young, fresh Riesling far removed from its Alsatian cousins. Great minerality and wonderful as an aperitif or with chicken or ham salad.

Riesling Signatur 2014 (12.0% ABV)

Richer and more powerful than the Kalkstein, this would go well with fish dishes with a sauce.

Domaine La Colombette - VDP des Coteaux du Libron, France

Sauvignon Blanc 2015/16 (11.5% ABV)

A wine of great aromatic strength with a subtle mix of fruit, including blackcurrant buds and citrus fruits. The taste lives up to the promising nose and is both lively and long.

Chardonnay 2015/16 (12.5% ABV)

Smooth Chardonnay aged for eight months in oak barrels to give it extra body; perfect with chicken and hard cheeses.

Domaine de Campaucels - Languedo, France


Picpoul de Pinet 2014/15 (12%ABV)

Fully organic Picpoul is rare, and it is even more rare to find one that is a delight - fresh, fruity with plenty of zing. Great as an aperitif or with chicken salad.

Bonnet Huteau - Muscadet Sevre et Maine AOC, France

Les Dabinières 2014/15 (12% ABV)

Melon de Bourgogne. A light wine with good acidity, bright minerality and clean tastes of delicious fruit. Apples on the finish. The perfect companion to seafood or fresh fish. *Biodynamic*

Les Jamelles - IGP Pays d'Oc, France

Chardonnay 2013/14 (13.0% ABV)

Gold yellow in colour; notes of apricots and pears with just a hint of white flowers on the nose. Well-balanced and with a good long finish. Excellent by itself or with chicken, cheese or even a salad.

Château de Lavernette - Burgundy, France

Beaujolais - Blanc 2013/14 (13.0% ABV)

Much rarer than its red brother, white Beaujolais deserves greater recognition. Pure Chardonnay, this wine from Château de Lavernette combines some of the richness of Burgundian whites but with greater acidity and freshness, making it ideal as both an aperitif and as an accompaniment with fish, chicken and salads.

Pouilly Fuissé, Jean-Jacques de Boissieu 2012/13 (13.0% ABV)

Pale straw yellow, with aromas of minerality. On the nose hints of vanilla along with citrus fruits. Rich and creamy in the mouth. Well-balanced with a great structure.

Clos Lapeyre - Jurançon, France

Vitige Vieilh 2010 (13% ABV)

A complex blend of Petit and Gros Manseng, this is very much a wine for food. Long, and full in the mouth, it goes well with chicken and hard cheeses.

Petit Chablis 2014 (12.0% ABV)

A younger borthor but just as attractive as the older sibling: clean and fresh, ideal as an aperitif.

Chablis Magnum 2014 (13.0% ABV)

Chardonnay. A wonderful Chablis that starts with a clean and sprightly minerality and ends with hints of apple and almonds. Brilliant with anything from the sea and also cured hams.

One of the very best Chablis 1er Crus, often on a par with a Grand Cru. Notable for its power and length, rich and honeyed in the mouth, this is a wine that can be drunk now but equally will evolve into a very special bottle over the next few years.

Clement Klur - AOC Alsace, France


Pinot Blanc Klur 2008 (13% ABV)

An elegant wine with a fine and fruity nose (white and exotic fruits) and a touch of granite minerality which develops smoothly on the palate. Light touch of noble rot, mineral and luscious, very structured.

Domaine du Roc des Anges - Maury, France

Llum 2012 (12.5% ABV)

80% Grenache Gris and 20% Maccabeu. A wine to be enjoyed on special occasions. It's complex, fresh and very unlike most white wines from the South of France. *Biodynamic*

Domaine Guillemot-Michel, - Mâcon, France

Viré-Clessé 2013/2014 (13.0% ABV)

We have been buying wines from this Domaine for over 20 years. This is Chardonnay at its very purest: made in small concrete tanks with no wood, the wines are fresh and full of fruit when young but evolve with time to become complex and concentrated. But whether they are drunk young or old, they retain balance, freshness and an incomparable ability to please.

Domaine Galévan - Rhône, France


Châteauneuf du Pape 2008 (13.5% ABV)

Grenache, Clairette, Roussane, Bourboulenc. A 9th generation vigneron, Coralie has made a fantastic wine. Pale yellow in colour with fresh citrus aromas and a smooth peach and lime taste. A wine for drinking now, but which will mature gently over the next ten years.

Domaine d'Ardhuy - Beaune, Burgundy

Beaune 1er Cru "Petit Clos des Theurons" 2013 (13.0% ABV)

Pale yellow with hints of green. Peaches, apricots and lemons on the nose, and soft and clean in the mouth with a beautifully long finish.

Bodegas Latue - Toledo, Spain


Tempranillo Azan 2014 (13.0% ABV)

An easy drinking House red with bags of red fruit and a well balanced finish. Perfect with a good steak.

Rioja 2014/15 (13.5% ABV)

Warm, easy drinking Rioja and very keenly priced.

Cielo y Tierra Winery - Italy

Merlot Ekue 2014/15 (12.0% ABV)

A fresh, smooth Merlot from Italy: gentle and round, good by itself or with almost any food.

Domaine La Colombette - VDP Coteaux du Libron, France

Syrah/Grenache 2013 (12.5% ABV)

A garnet red colour, aromas of ripe red fruits, a soft mouth, sharp and spicy. Drink young and slightly chilled. Goes well with grilled meats or white meats.

Bodega Lo Necesario, Diego Fernandez Pons - Valencia, Spain

La Vida en Rojo, Syrah 2015 (14% ABV)

A really appealing Syrah from Spain - full, round, smooth; delicious during the autumn and winter months and great value for money.

Las Aves de Paso 2013/14 (13.5% ABV)

Made from the little known Bobal grape by a passionate winemaker, this is a proper Spanish red - concentrated, rich and complex. Wonderful aromas of tobacco and spices, and elegant tannins combine with a long mouth to give a wine that is perfect with game or a hard cheese.

Bodega Enguera - Valencia, Spain


Crianza 2013 (14% ABV)

Deep ruby colour, plenty of spice and leather on the nose and a smooth long finish make this rich red from Valencia a perfect match for red meat and strong pasta sauces.

Château Ferran - Bordeaux Superior, France

Château Ferran 2013 (12.0% ABV)


Easy drinking Bordeaux. Lovely cherry colour, the nose hints at plums and red fruits. Gentle on the mouth, ideal with chicken and cold meats.

Jasci Donatello - Montepulciano D'Abruzzo, Italy

Montepulciano 2014 (13.0% ABV)

Red fruits, jams, and a touch of chocolate. A well-balanced and harmonious wine that is rich with a lovely intense ruby red colour. Best with meat dishes or gnocchi.

Les Janelles - IGP Pays d'Oc France


Merlot 2013 (13.5% ABV)

Deep, almost black in colour with strong expressive aromas of black fruit. Soft easy drinking with a velvety palate. Smooth enough to drink by itself but with enough body to go with meat and pasta.

Château La Baronne - AOP Corbières, France

Domaine des Lanes 2013 (14.0% ABV)

Grenache 50%, Carignan 50%. A lively wine with a rich raspberry hue. Flavours of dried fruits and cassis with a slightly smoky note. An easy drinking and well-made Languedoc.

Las Vals 2008/12 (14.5% ABV) - IGP Hauterive, France


Mourvèdre 95%, Syrah 5%. Filled with rich fruit, chocolate flavours and autumn aromas. Blackberries and spice. A very well-balanced, smooth wine with a long finish and great tannins. Delicious with juicy meats and rich sauces.

Clos des Boutes - Costières de Nîmes, France

Les Pluriel 2014 (13.5% ABV)

Les Pluriel Magnum 2014 (13.5% ABV)


Carignan and Syrah, with just a touch of Grenache. Red and black fruits on the nose, followed by a mouth which gives hints of spice. Full, almost chewable.

Château de Lavernette - Burgundy, France

Beaujolais Villages 2014/15 (13.0% ABV)

Château de Lavernette have used their 35 year old Gamay vines to make a very superior Beaujolais. Low yields and careful cellar work have given plenty of fruit on the nose and a well-balanced mouth, supple tannins giving just enough chew to make this a good wine for sipping over a plate of charcuterie.

Domaine Despaigne Rapin - Saint Emilion, France


Les Piliers de Maison Blanche 2009 (14.0% ABV)

A classic claret blend of Cabernet Franc/Merlot. The nose is black fruit, so ripe that it is almost jammy enough to taste; in the mouth - full and round with elegant tannins that add rather than detract. A wine that will go to perfection with most red meats, particularly if accompanied by a sauce.

Garances Rouge - Côtes du Rhône, France


Garance Rouge 2012 (14.5% ABV)

This vineyard's flagship wine. A deep, powerful Provençal wine, full-bodied with good acidity. Morello cherries and a hint of liquorice in the mouth. Excellent with red meat.

Les Clos Perdus - Languedoc/Roussillon, France

Cuvee 91/Cuvee 101 2011/12 (14.0% ABV)

A blend of Grenache, Carignan and Mourvedre, this has taken over from the Cuvee 71 which was such a success. Lots of sweet, charming purple berry fruit and an enjoyable chewiness to it. Drinking now through 2017. *Biodynamic*

Prioundo 2011 (14.0% ABV)

Grenache and Cinsaut and the blend of these two gentle grape varieties give a sweet and luscious wine. Very clean, it is less powerful than the Cuvee 91, but just as enjoyable. *Biodynamic*

L'Extreme Rouge 2013 (14.0% ABV)


This is a massive wine, while managing to remain smooth and well-balanced. Made from Lladoner Pelut and Syrah with a long fermentation period and 20 months in barrels, this is concentrated Roussillon at its best. To be drunk with red meats, game or a cassoulet.

Domaine d'Ardhuy, Beaune, Burgundy

Bourgogne Pinot Noir Rouge 2014 (12.5% ABV)

Although only a generic 'Bourgogne', this wine still reeks of class: supple and smooth, it evokes the best of young Pinot Noir, made by a top class Burgundian Domaine. Good value for money.

Ladoix Rouge 2013 (13.0% ABV)

Fruity and soft in the mouth with charming aromas of strawberry and cherry. Will complement grilled meat, poultry and cold cuts.

Pernand Vergelesses Rouge 2013 (13.0% ABV)

A very well balanced wine: gentle aromas of blackberries and strawberries, with smooth tannins. Excellent with lamb or cheese.

Nuits Saint Georges "Aux Herbues aux Argilats" 2013 (13.0% ABV)


Deep red robe with purplish tints gives a nose of blackcurrants with notes of venison and leather. A meaty Burgundy made to go with red meats and game.

Domaine du Roc des Anges - Maury, France

Reliefs 2011/13 (14.0% ABV)

60% Carignan, 25% Grenache and 15% Syrah. An unusually elegant red from the Roussillon. Goes wonderfully well with duck and with stew. *Biodynamic*

Château Gravier Figeac - Bordeaux - Saint Emilion, France

Château Gravier Figeac 2010 (13% ABV)

100% Merlot, harvested by hand and aged for 6 months in old oak barrels, this is a fine Claret. Rich and spicy nose, a full and chewy mouth; ideal with beef, game or other red meats.

Domaine Hauvette, St Remy de Provence, France


Cornaline 2009 (13.5% ABV).

Dominique Hauvette is one of the star winemakers in the South of France, and this wine shows why - rich and powerful yet with great balance and elegance, this will go to perfection with roast lamb and flageolets.

L'Or de Line 2012 (13.5% ABV)

Classic Châteauneuf blend of the 13 different grape varieties. Supple and smooth, this is drinking exceptionally well right now.

Rosé 2015/16 (11.5% ABV)

Rosé Magnum 2015/16 (11.5% ABV)

Grenache. This light fruity rosé is only 11.5% which can be enjoyed throughout a summer's day. The wine is vibrant and well-balanced with hints of citrus fruits and strawberries. Goes perfectly with salads and seafood.

Bodega Robles - Montilla Moriles, Spain


Piedra Luenga Fino 2012 (15.0% ABV) (50cl)

Pedro Ximénez. One of the very few organic producers of sherry. This fantastic aperitif is very smooth and light, full of freshness and vivacity. Green almonds and lemons.

Moelleux 2012 (12.0% ABV) (50cl)

Fruity, delicate and complex. A mixture of Petit and Gros Manseng, this is packed full of exotic and citrus flavours creating a delicious and unctuous light dessert wine.
